The adult (18-65) community mental health transformation (no wrong door) programme across Hampshire, Southampton, Isle of Wight, and Portsmouth is inviting grant applications, of up to £8,000, from organisations within the community and voluntary sector (CVS) to deliver a project to advance mental health equalities (AMHE) and support better mental health outcomes for underrepresented groups in the local area. The project, programme or activity should be able to demonstrate how it is helping to improve access, outcomes, experience, data collection or raise awareness of mental health services in the community.

We are running a virtual event on MS Teams for prospective applicants from the community voluntary sector to discuss the grant programme, application process, priority groups in local areas and any thoughts on projects, programmes, and activities.
