Executive Summary

This month the verbal update to the Board will include a number of issues that are relevant to the CCG and the wider health and care system. During the meeting we will be hearing from a patient who has had experience of the long-Covid service. This is hugely topical and we will continue to ground our meetings in the real experiences of our patients and communities.

This update includes a focus on our key priorities:

- Ensuring a safe **winter** is a top priority. In common with health and care systems across the country, we are anticipating that due to a combination of factors, winter this year will be one of our most challenging.
- The continued roll out of the **COVID-19 vaccination programme**. Progress has been positive with 91.7 % of eligible groups now having receiving two doses of the vaccine and ensuring widespread protection for our communities. Roll out of the COVID-19 booster vaccination also continues at pace. Following the recent Government announcement about the extension of the COVID-19 booster programme in response to the Omicron variant, our teams are working hard to extend the roll out to all eligible groups and ensure there is capacity to deliver the vaccinations across our area.
- Continued focus on **elective care and reducing waiting times** for patients
- Continuing with the development and the establishment of the **Hampshire and Isle of Wight Integrated Care System (ICS)**.
- Looking after our **workforce** to ensure that they are able to focus on our priorities
- Further our **engagement with our local communities** to understand and address the issues that matter to them
